

ALIMA UK Cookie Notice

This Cookie Notice explains how the Alliance for International Medical Action (“ALIMA”, “we”, “us”, or “our”) uses “cookies” on our website and applies to all individuals who access or use this website.

Our website uses cookies to distinguish you from other users of our website. This helps us to provide you with a good experience when you browse our website and also allows us to improve our site.

A cookie is a small file of letters and numbers that we store on your browser or the hard drive of your computer if you agree. Other, similar tracking technologies exist (such as pixels). For the purposes of this Cookie Notice, reference to cookies should be read to include these similar technologies.

What are “essential” and “non-essential” cookies?

Cookies that are strictly necessary for our website to work are called “essential” cookies. These are placed when you first access our website, and the law states that we do not need your consent to place these. All other cookies are known as “non-essential” cookies. We will only place non-essential cookies where you have given us your explicit consent.

What cookies we use

Cookies make the use of our website easier by, among other things, saving your preferences. We may also use cookies to deliver content tailored to your interests. Our cookies may enable us to relate your use of the website to personal data that you previously provided. The information that we collect with cookies allows us to statistically analyse usage of the website, and to improve and customise our content and other offerings.

However, we only disclose information collected with cookies to third parties on an aggregated basis without the use of any information that personally identifies you. The specific types of first party and third party cookies placed by our website and the purposes they perform are described in the table below:

When will we collect cookies?

When you first access our website from certain jurisdictions, you will receive a banner seeking your consent for the use of non-essential cookies.

By clicking “Accept” you signify that you understand and agree to the use of these cookies. If you do not wish to provide your consent, you may click “Refuse” to reject all non-essential cookies or “Settings” to reject specific cookies.

How to control cookies

You do not have to accept cookies, and consent can be withdrawn at any time. You can also change your browser settings to refuse or restrict cookies, and you may delete them after they have been placed on your device at any time. If you do not accept or delete our cookies, some areas of the website that you access may take more time to work or may not function properly. Unless you've set your browser to refuse cookies, our system will issue essential cookies as soon you visit our website.

You can also activate settings on your browser that allows you to refuse all or some cookies on all websites you visit, or delete cookies already placed. Please follow the links below to helpful information for the most popular browsers:
